What does Home-Start Deveron offer?

Home-Start Deveron operates throughout the Deveron Valley area, serving Aberchirder, Banff, Huntly, Macduff, Portsoy, Turriff and surrounding areas.

Home-Start Deveron offers Allsorts group (for parents with children over 18mths to pre-school), Bookbug, Baby Massage classes, Stay and Play groups, Baby Buddies groups (for parents with children under 18 months), Twinkles (a group for parents with twins or more!), parenting advice, financial guidance, one-to-one support and more.

Home-Start Deveron can help families with many issues, for example:

- living in rural and social isolation with
- inadequate public transport
- drug and alcohol abuse
- domestic abuse
- living with terminal illness
- coping with post natal depression
- coping with children affected with disability
- families finding parenting a struggle

As a volunteer what would I do?

Usually you visit a family in their own home once a week for a couple of hours. How you help is really down to the family itself. Some might need someone to talk to, others may need more practical support with meal planning and cooking, reading to the children, going to the local park or finding out about local services.

Can my support and friendship really make a difference?

All parents know that those early years before children go off to school are vital and at Home-Start Deveron we believe parents have the key role in creating a secure childhood for their children. It's just that sometimes they need a bit of **your** help.



Do I need any qualifications to be a volunteer?

The only real 'qualification' is experience of bringing up children. Friendliness and a caring attitude are essential as well as an understanding of the pressures of parenting. We value people who don't judge others; people who will respect the fact that they have been invited into a family's home; people who will treat a mother or father as an equal.
